Judging will be done on the basis of appearance and quality of construction, according to the information you present on the form and the artwork submitted, with emphasis on design creativity and functionality. Please feel free to use additional pages if you need more space to answer any question.

All projects entered must have been completed since January 1, 2008, and must have been built for an outside customer (i.e. someone other than an employee of the shop submitting the entry). Each entry must be accompanied by a check or credit card authorization for \$45. All entries must also be accompanied by **professional-quality** artwork of the project/item being submitted. Photographs or digital images that are 266 DPI or higher, are preferred. Digital images **MUST** be accompanied by a color print-out of the image(s). All materials become the property of CUSTOM WOODWORKING BUSINESS.

Winners and honorable mentions will be announced and featured in the December 2009 issue of CWB. The top winner in each category will receive an award plaque and 100 reprints of the article. Honorable mentions will receive a certificate and 50 reprints.

Please note that the deadline for submission of all materials is Sept. 15, 2009.
